## Conditions of Entry

This competition shall be conducted under the Solo Drumming Rules of the Paeroa Highland Games & Tattoo. (Drummers are not required to be a member of the Piping and Dancing Assn of NZ to compete in these events.)

All Snare Drum competitors are to be accompanied by a piper and all Tenor and Bass Competitors are to be accompanied by a piper & Snare Drummer as per the contest rules.

Competitors MUST report to Board Stewards upon arrival at the grounds.

A guide to event times will be posted before the contest and can be forwarded to you upon request.

### Important:

Please Note that this year solo drumming events will be held and prizes awarded on the basis of entries per event.

This means

2 Entries needed before an event to be held.

2---3 entries, 1<sup>st</sup> Prize only awarded,

4---5 Entries 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Prizes awarded,

6---7 Entries 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Prizes awarded,
